PEL is looking for an experienced expatriate Project Manager for its Kandra Gas Field located in Sindh province of Pakistan. The job requirements / responsibilities and qualification / experience are given below;

Job Description:

Development of a Low BTU Kandra Gas Field of PEL for supply of processed gas commingled with pipeline quality gas for supply to Kandra Power Company (KPC).

In addition an exploration project will be developed to test deeper formations (Chiltan, Lower Goru and Triassic).

Job Responsibilities:

Development

The position offers challenging opportunities for growth and success. As in-charge of gas field operations, the Project Manager will have to ensure application of professional principles and techniques such as planning, monitoring and all other aspects of the project execution including inter-alia gas production, processing, CO₂ disposal, control of project schedules and costs, and mitigation of risks. For timely completion of the project, the good Oil/Gas field practices, international standards and the applicable policies and laws will have to be kept in view. The job responsibility will include the following:

- Revision of development plan and approval of JV Partners in (TCM/OCM) as well as the approval of the Government as per applicable Rules
- Approval of annual work program and budget from JV Partners, AFEs, Cash Calls
- EIA study and approvals from concerned EPA as per environmental laws
- Selection of well sites, ROW, land acquisition, compensation and civil works
- Arrangements for water requirements
- Arrange drilling rig and other services, evaluation of bids, negotiations and award of contracts on most competitive terms as per JOA and mobilization thereof

Ordering of materials and equipment, vehicles and surface facilities

- Well design, casing, mud program, logging, sampling and coring
- Supervise drilling and completion of wells
- Installation of surface facilities, pipelines, storage tanks, processing plants, custody transfer, metering, CO₂ disposal and facilities for commingling of processed gas with pipeline quality gas to be purchased from SSGCL and / or other sources.
- Residential facilities for workers, staff and officers in the field.
- Sale/purchase agreements with the gas utility/ others for purchase of pipeline quality gas as well as with power purchaser for supply of gas.
- Finalization of Gas Pricing Agreement with GOP and notification of gas prices by OGRA.
- Liaison with Provincial and Federal Government authorities including but not limited to Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), DGPC, OGRA, SSGCL, KPC, EPA, Central Inspector of Mines, and Chief Inspector of Explosives
- Any other matter as may be assigned by the management.

Exploration

The company has full exploration rights to explore and test the deeper formations in Kandra D&P Lease. The company drilled a deep well in 2008 to test the potential of Chiltan formation at a depth of 2158-2229 m. The well encountered good quality gas of 803 BTU/scf.

Kandra structure is a 4-way dip closed, basement induced high and extends from Sui Main Limestone (SML) top deeper formations of Triassic age.

Exploration Program in Kandra lease envisages drilling and testing of Chiltan Limestone and deeper Triassic formations. A detailed analysis of existing data would be required to evaluate the potential of these formations and based thereon to design an exploration program. The main objective of such an exploration program would be to find and use the sweet gas for commingling with low BTU SML gas for power generation. The Project Manager will be required to evaluate, design and implement the exploration program for testing deeper formations in Kandra Lease. This would envisage approvals from JV/GOP and arrangements for exploratory drilling in deeper formations in the Lease including selection of rig, services, and all other facilities.

Qualifications & Experience

The candidates should have a dynamic personality with the following qualifications and experience.

- Graduate in Mechanical, Chemical, Petroleum Engineering. Preference will be given to candidates having post graduate qualifications from a foreign University.
- MBA in Project Management will be an added qualification.
- Minimum of 15-20 years experience with an E&P company including managerial level experience of developing/successful implementation of major E&P projects and gas field development.
